God's Response

Create in me a clean heart, O God. Renew a right spirit within me.

Psalm 51:10

Do not despise these small beginnings, for the LORD rejoices to see the work begin. Zechariah 4:10

Let the Spirit renew your thoughts and attitudes. Put on your new nature. *Ephesians 4:23-24 (NLT-2)*
