BEGINNINGS

TODAY'S PROMISE

Great is his faithfulness; his mercies begin afresh each morning.

—LAMENTATIONS 3:23

TODAY'S THOUGHT

Life is a series of beginnings, and how you enter into them makes all the difference. Although the thought of new beginnings sometimes makes you feel anxious, remember that you experience them all the time. Each day brings a whole series of new opportunities, including opportunities to get to know God better and to start over with a new attitude toward circumstances and people in your life. God's mercy toward you is new every day, no matter what you've done or how you've treated him or other people the day before. That means you don't have to be burdened by yesterday's failures or regrets.

TODAY'S PLAN

Do you give new mercies each day to the people you live and work with, just as God gives new mercies to you?

JANUARY 2

BEGINNINGS

TODAY'S PROMISE

Create in me a clean heart, O God. Renew a loyal spirit within me.

—PSALM 51:10

TODAY'S THOUGHT

You harvest what you plant. Pumpkin seeds produce pumpkins. Sunflower seeds produce sunflowers. If you have sinful desires and thoughts, it is evidence that some bad seeds have been planted in your heart, and you need to do some weeding. You must beg the Lord to plant within you a clean heart so that your life will produce clean thoughts, motives, and actions. Complete renewal cannot be accomplished yet. None of us will be entirely "clean" in this life, but one of the most worthy goals you can pursue this year is purity of mind and heart.

TODAY'S PLAN

Can you make purity of mind and heart your goal for today? What might you look like a year from now—inside and out—if you met this goal not just today but every day?

JANUARY 3

CALL OF GOD

TODAY'S PROMISE

I knew you before I formed you in your mother's womb. Before you were born I set you apart and appointed you as my prophet to the nations.

—JEREMIAH 1:5

TODAY'S THOUGHT

You might think that God was only speaking to the prophet Jeremiah in these verses. But God calls everyone to do a certain job, to accomplish a specific task, or to use his or her gifts in a unique way. When God calls you to do something, he will make sure you know what it is. Often you will feel a strong sense of leading from him. It's up to you to respond and walk through the door of opportunity he opens.

TODAY'S PLAN

Do you have a strong sense that God is leading you in a certain direction or asking you to serve him in some way? How can you begin to respond to God's call in practical ways today?

JANUARY 4

GIFTS

TODAY'S PROMISE

There are different kinds of spiritual gifts, but the same Spirit is the source of them all. There are different kinds of service, but we serve the same Lord. God works in different ways, but it is the same God who does the work in all of us.

—1 CORINTHIANS 12:4-6

TODAY'S THOUGHT

The natural abilities you have are gifts from God, and they are often a clue to what God wants you to do. Would God give you certain talents and spiritual gifts and then not ask you to use them? You may have natural gifts in the area of cooking, entertaining, managing a business, teaching, handling money, playing an instrument, or any number of other things. Use whatever gifts you have to bring honor and glory to God. Then you will be right where you need to be to discover God's will for you and to accomplish his purpose for you.

TODAY'S PLAN

How is God calling you to serve him with your gifts in the coming year?

JANUARY 5

PRAYER

TODAY'S PROMISE

Keep on asking, and you will receive what you ask for. Keep on seeking, and you will find. Keep on knocking, and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks, receives. Everyone who seeks, finds. And to everyone who knocks, the door will be opened.

TODAY'S THOUGHT

There's more to prayer than just getting an answer to a question or a solution for a problem. God often does more in your heart through your act of prayer than he does in the actual answer to your prayer. As you persist in talking and listening to God, he promises that you will gain greater understanding of yourself and your situation as well as God's purpose for you and his direction for your life.

TODAY'S PROMISE

TODAY'S THOUGHT

Many people picture God as stern and vindictive, just watching and waiting for the chance to zap humans with bolts of misfortune. But this verse shows the opposite. God loves you and wants only good things for you. He wants your future—both in this life and in heaven—to be bright and hopeful.

TODAY'S PLAN

How can you begin to recognize God's goodness all around you?

JANUARY 7

BIBLE

TODAY'S PROMISE

All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right. God uses it to prepare and equip his people to do every good work.

TODAY'S THOUGHT

If you buy a new computer but neglect to read the instruction manual, you'll miss out on many of the functions the machine is capable of doing. You'll be operating with just enough knowledge to perform basic functions. When it comes to reading the Bible, most of us read just enough to get by. We miss so much of what God's Word has to offer. If you've ever spent two hours stuck in rush-hour traffic or held a crying baby at two o'clock in the morning, you know something about patience. According to the Bible, patience is a form of perseverance and endurance that allows you to respond to frustrating circumstances with grace and self-control. Contrary to popular opinion, patience is not merely a personality trait; it is a by-product of the presence and work of the Holy Spirit in the heart and mind of the believer. God promises that when the Holy Spirit is in you, he will produce more patience in your life.

TODAY'S PLAN

How can you give the Holy Spirit greater control over your life?

JANUARY 9

JOY

TODAY'S PROMISE

You will show me the way of life, granting me the joy of your presence and the pleasures of living with you forever.

—PSALM 16:11

TODAY'S THOUGHT

God does not promise that your life will always be happy. In fact, the Bible assumes problems will come your way. But God does promise lasting joy for all those who sincerely follow him. If you trust him, you have the assurance that the God of the universe loves you, wants to know you, promises to comfort and care for you, and has guaranteed your eternal future with him. This kind of joy stays with you despite your problems, and it helps you get through them without being overwhelmed.

TODAY'S PLAN

Can you tell the difference between happiness and joy?

JANUARY 10

GOALS

TODAY'S PROMISE

Sympathize with each other. Love each other as brothers and sisters. Be tenderhearted, and keep a humble attitude. Don't repay evil for evil. Don't retaliate with insults when people insult you. Instead, pay them back with a blessing. That is what God has called you to do, and he will bless you for it.

—1 PETER 3:8-9

TODAY'S THOUGHT

While it's good to set big goals for family, career, or personal achievements, it's also important to set smaller daily goals. You can determine today to be kind toward others, to be humble, to respond gracefully even when someone takes advantage of you, to read your Bible, to say an encouraging word—these are small goals that bring great rewards when practiced over a lifetime. God promises to bless you for such small goals of obedience to him, for they become the essential building blocks of all the things God wants you to accomplish.
