

## INTRODUCTION

THE BIBLE IS GOD'S STORY. It is also the story of all humanity, of their actions—both good and evil. The Bible is an important book because it shows us who God is and who he created us to be. The Epic Bible is a graphic adaptation of the Bible that attempts to tell the story of the real and true Word of God in serialized art form. Bible references appear at the bottom of each page where there is a direct relation to a Bible verse or story, and the narration and dialogue closely follow the text of the *Holy Bible*, New Living Translation. We strongly encourage all our graphic-novel readers to read the complete Bible story for themselves. God has much to teach us!

This adaptation seeks to introduce readers to the major themes and threads of the Bible. The story begins when God creates all things by speaking them into existence, and it follows Adam and Eve's descendants as they struggle with how to repair their broken relationship with their Creator. After this, God calls Abraham and his family to be the people through whom God will save the whole world. In the story of Moses, God's people travel all the way to the land that he promised to give to their ancestors, where God reveals his law to his people to show them how to live in covenant with him.

God brings his people into the Promised Land and establishes Israel as a great nation. But, as forewarned by Moses and the prophets, disaster awaits when the people turn away from and sin against the living God. The people's disobedience and unfaithful rulers lead them into exile in Babylon. Eventually, they return home and rebuild their temple and cities. After all this comes a time of four hundred silent years before the Messiah is revealed to the people of Israel and to the world.

Finally, God comes to earth in human form to save us all, as seen in Jesus' birth, life, death, and resurrection. The risen Jesus tells his disciples to make more disciples, and as the Holy Spirit empowers the followers of Christ to spread his message across the globe, the church is born. Christ selects the apostle Paul to share the Good News with Gentiles (non-Jews). Letters from Paul and other church leaders teach us how Jesus wants his followers to live. Revelation, the final book of the Bible, reveals that the darkness and turmoil of this sinful world will be interrupted and defeated by the glorious return of Jesus Christ as he sets up his Kingdom that will never end.

We are excited about sharing this story with you in a new way! Our prayer is that God will speak to you powerfully and show you his love and faithfulness in this book.













































