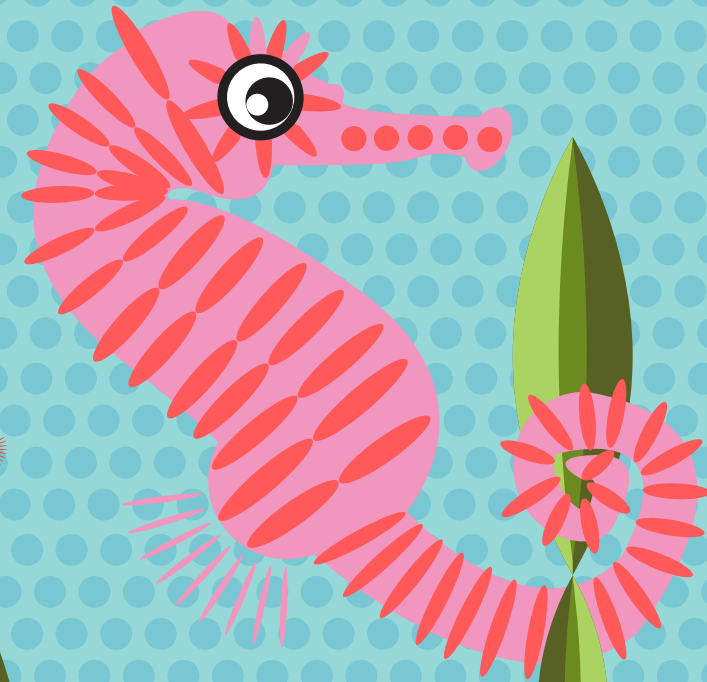
God made the ocean's creatures and waves,
treasures in the watery world—


like the oyster, who lives in a cozy shell
